

**MARIAN LOFTIN CHILD CHAMPION
LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD**



The Marian Loftin Child Champion Lifetime Achievement Award has been established to recognize an individual who has focused their life's work on championing for children in our State. This award will recognize extraordinary, distinguished, and dedicated efforts to enhance children's chances for growing up in stable, nurturing, empowering families and communities.

Review Process and Criteria:

The Award Committee seeks evidence of (1) accomplishment and impact, (2) dedication and leadership, and (3) policy innovation as the three areas of selection criteria.

Submission Procedure and Deadlines:

Each nomination must include:

1. A concise description (not to exceed 2 double spaced pages) of the nominee's work in each of the 3 areas
 2. A brief resume or vita
- Two letters (two page maximum) in support of the nomination are recommended.
 - Applications may include supporting documentation, including video, but this is not required.

Submissions will be reviewed by the Awards Committee of the Alabama Community Healthy Marriage Initiative.

All nominations must be e-mailed, faxed (334-844-8709) or postmarked no later than **June 15, 2010**. Nominations received after the deadline will not be considered for the current year's award.
